1. Call to Order by Chair Taylor at 6:30 pm.
2. Pledge of Allegiance

BUSINESS

1. Discuss/vote motions and reports to April 2024 Annual Town Meeting as needed.
There was no discussion or vote of motions and reports.
2. Discuss, consider and vote date for November 2024 Town Meeting
November 18, 2024.

Mr. Zylinski made a motion to approve the November 18, 2024 Town Meeting date. Mr. Mascali seconded the motion. Vote: Yes-5. No-0.

3. Discuss and vote to petition the State Traffic Engineer for speed limit changes along Woods Hole Road in Falmouth pursuant to MGL Chapter 90 Section 18 as amended by Chapter 358 of the Acts of 2022

Article 24.

Mr. Renshaw explained Chapter 358 and section 13 of the act, noting a copy in the packet and brought attention to page 79 with highlighted section was reviewed, to modify the speed limit, request in writing, they have 90 days to approve or deny. This is a petitioners article, Mr. Renshaw recommended the Select Board approve the submission and include exhibit A, map of Woods Hole Road.

Mr. Zylinski made a motion to approve the submission of a petition to the State Traffic Engineer for speed limit changes along Woods Hole Road in Falmouth, as reflected in the map marked as Exhibit A, and pursuant to MGL Chapter 90 section 18 as amended by Chapter 358 of the Acts of 2022. Ms. Scott Price seconded the motion. Vote: Yes-5. No-0.

4. Vote to accept grant award in the amount of \$4,545.00 from Falmouth Road Race, Inc. to the Falmouth Beach Department to purchase rescue boards, storage bins, megaphones, pull buoys and parking attendant chairs

Mr. Renshaw explained this grant application that was submitted, the request was granted for those items. It is recommended the Select Board accept the award.

Ms. Scott Price motion to accept the grant award. Mr. Zylinski seconded the motion. Vote: Yes-5. No-0.
